New Life Solutions

Award Amount: \$88,910

Purpose of Grant: Clients come to A Woman's Place Medical Clinics with backgrounds full of all types of "trauma-related" issues. Many are also experiencing an unplanned pregnancy. This grant will provide access to Christian counselors trained in trauma-related services through a partnership with Life Connections Counseling Center.



A Message from New Life Solutions:

After emigrating from Venezuela last winter, Diana*, who was four months pregnant, made an appointment at our clinic in Pinellas Park. She was suffering from prenatal depression due to severe trauma and mistreatment she had endured from the baby's father. Our client advocate suggested our free counseling to help her work through her past experiences. During her sessions she found hope and healing! She now shares that she's an emotionally healthy and happy mother. In her words, "A Woman's Place saved my life."
